Education

Founded in 1995, Sécurité Nature ensures that hunters and anglers practice their activities safely and ethically by adopting an appropriate code of conduct.

In Québec, this organization is responsible for providing courses for an education program on safety and wildlife conservation.

The program, called Programme d'Éducation en Sécurité et en Conservation de la Faune (PESCOF) is required study for obtaining a hunter's certificate.



PESCOF* MANAGER


A volunteer who takes care of the complex but motivating task of coordinating all of their region's monitors.



PROJECTS AND ACTIONS





HEADQUARTERS

In addition to permanent offices, various exhibitions and Boisé Héritage Faune are open to the public and admission is free. They are an important window on education and wildlife conservation.



REINTRODUCTION OF THE STRIPED BASS

(Operation renaissance)

Following a FédéCP initiative, several million striped bass were reintroduced into the St. Lawrence River. This species had disappeared in the mid-1960s.

Thanks to the involvement of many volunteers, striped bass are once again swimming in the river.



WILD TURKEY

To promote the wild turkey, the federation carried out a relocation program to accelerate the species' establishment in Québec.

Thanks to volunteers, the wild turkey is now part of our wildlife heritage and prospers in several regions.

IMAGE CAMPAIGN

Over the years, the Federation has developed and organized several campaigns to raise awareness about the values and importance of hunting, fishing, and the safe handling and storage of firearms.
